






WHY OUR STUDIES?




LOGISTIC LABORATORIES



COSTS OF LIFE IN WROCŁAW



- Insurance each student is obliged to get standard insurance - 50 PLN,
- Accomodation room in a dormitory costs approximately 450 PLN,
- Municipal public transport a ticket for a single ride for student costs 1.70 PLN, but it is possible to buy a monthly ticket which costs 45 PLN,
- Food there are many spots around the city in which students can buy cheap meals. The average cost of such meal is 8-12 PLN,
- Cinema ticket for those who enjoy watching movies - the average cost of a single cinema ticket is 15-20 PLN.



SUPPORT FOR STUDENTS

- Help with receiving Polish visas by preparing all necessary documents,
- Study Buddy programme help with getting to know Wrocław,
