

EDUCATION PROGRAM

One of the key elements of the internationalization of the International University of Logistics and Transport in Wroclaw is gaining experience by students as well as by academic and administrative staff thanks to international mobility taking place in close cooperation with foreign partner universities.

Therefore, we are pleased to present the **Education Program** and the **Mobility in higher education** project implemented as part of it.

What is the Education Program?

The Education Program benefits from funding received from Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway under the Financial Mechanism of the European Economic Area (EEA FM) for 2014-2021, which represents the contribution of these countries towards a green, competitive and inclusive Europe.

The operator of the Education Program in Poland is the **Foundation for the Development of the Education System** with its registered office in Warsaw.

Project goal

The project "Mobility in higher education (Component II)" as a part of Education Program (project no. EOG/21/K2/W/0017) being implemented at the International University of Logistics and Transport in Wroclaw benefits from a grant of EUR 20,000 received from Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway under the EEA funds.

The aim of the "Mobility in higher education" project is to reduce economic and social disparities within the European Economic Area and to strengthen bilateral relations between Poland and the Donor States (Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway) in the field of education. Program activities are aimed at strengthening human potential and expanding knowledge in Poland.

The project will generate results that could not be achieved only in one country. It is expected to achieve mainly intangible results, among others in the following areas:

- Professional skills (expanding knowledge of logistics, improving professional and language competences),
- Motivation level (increased motivation to learn, increased self-confidence),
- Cultural competences (increasing openness, acceptance, tolerance),
- Personal competences (raising the level of self-esteem, independence, acquiring communication skills).

Mobility information

As part of the 2021 call for proposals, IULT in Wroclaw has received funding to implement mobility with the following partners:

Molde University College - Specialized University in Logistics (Norway)

Mobilities of **students** and **staff** of higher education institutions are based on Erasmus+ program mobility rules for Higher Education but they are financed by the Education Program.

Mobilities take place within 2 flows: from Poland to the Donor States and from the Donor States to Poland.

Student mobility for studies

The mobilities of Polish students to universities in the Donor States and the mobilities of students from the Donor States to Poland last 5 <u>months in one academic year</u>.

- * When qualifying students, the following criteria are taken into account:
- performance,
- knowledge of the foreign language in which classes are conducted at the host university.

Staff mobilities

- **Staff mobility for teaching** at the partner university lasts maximum 5 days. During the mobility at the partner university, the staff member must carry out a minimum of 8 hours of classes.
- **Staff mobility for training** at the partner university to carry out job shadowing activities, participate in seminars, trainings and conferences improving skills and expanding knowledge in a given field, lasts maximum 5 days.
- *When qualifying academic teachers, the following criteria are taken into account:
- didactic program,
- didactic achievements,
- knowledge of foreign language in which the academic staff member will conduct classes.
- *When qualifying administrative staff, the following criteria are taken into account:
- the expected impact of the training/mobility abroad on professional development,
- knowledge of foreign language in which the training will be conducted.
